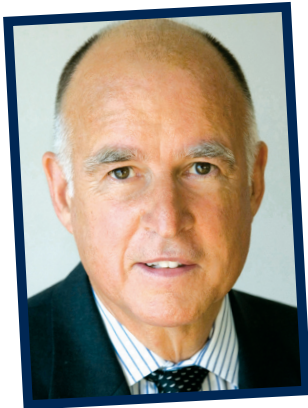

Event Information – General Public:

Please note, the event will be taking place indoors, at SJSU Event Center. This is a standing-rally style event – please wear comfortable footwear. This event is free to the public, but requires RSVP at www.cadem.org/ClintonVote2010Rallies and a ticket for admission. Tickets will be available for pick-up at check-in on the event date.

Parking:

The primary parking garage is located at the 7th Street South Garage, on the south-west end of campus. Parking is also available in nearby city-owned parking lots. (Please see below map)

Prohibited Items:

- No laptop computers, sharp objects, weapons, metal or plastic drink bottles, backpacks and bags or purses larger than a standard sheet of paper.
- No posters or signs of any size will be permitted.
- No food or drink can be carried in.
- Cameras and video cameras are permitted.
- There will be a drop-box for prohibited items at the entry gate.

Accessibility:

Individuals with mobility disabilities should park in the 7th Street South Garage, and enter through the marked VIP/Volunteer entrance. American Sign Language services will be available upon request.
